2. EDUCATION ADMINISTRATION

2.1 Approval of Accessory One MiFi Devices Purchase and Monthly AT&T Subscription Services

BACKGROUND INFORMATION: On March 4, 2020 California Governor Gavin Newsom proclaimed a State of Emergency as a result of the threat of COVID-19. On March 15, 2020, Sierra Sands Unified School District Superintendent, Dr. Dave Ostash, enacted school closures to reduce the impact of COVID-19 effective March 17 through April 14, 2020. Governor Newsom's Executive Order N-26-20, provided the following guidance regarding the delivery of educational opportunities during school closures:

- 2. If an LEA closes its schools to address COVID-19, as provided in Paragraph 4 of this Order, the LEA will continue to receive state funding to support the following during the period of closure:
- (i) Continue delivering high-quality educational opportunities to students to the extent feasible through, among other options, distance learning and/or independent study.

In order to support an equitable distance learning model for all Sierra Sands students, both electronic devices and access to the internet is required during school closures.

<u>CURRENT CONSIDERATIONS</u>: A Devices and Internet Access Google Survey was provided to all parents/guardians to determine student needs. Based upon the identified electronic device needs, the district is prepared to provide Chromebooks to students requiring an electronic device in the distance learning model. Based upon the identified internet access needs, the district proposes a 200 MiFi devices purchase and AT&T subscription services to support students in the distance learning model.

<u>FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS</u>: Contracts over \$10,000 require board approval. The estimate for 200 MiFi devices is \$13,800. The estimated monthly cost to support 200 MiFi devices is \$10,000 (200 modems at \$50/month) and will be multifunded through the district's Title I and Title IV allocations.

<u>SUPERINTENDENT'S RECOMMENDATION</u>: It is recommended that the board approve the expenditures as presented.
