- 1 3-ring binder (3-inch) with front clear protective sleeve
- 1 package of page protectors (50 count)



Boys

- 1 box facial tissue

Girls

- 1 bottle of hand sanitizer

1st Grade

- 1 pair headphones (for personal use)
- 5 packages of dry-erase markers
- 1 pack highlighter markers yellow or orange
- 5 packages of washable markers
- 6 dozen wooden pencils (#2-sharpened, no decorations)
- 4 packages of small glue sticks
- 3 boxes of facial tissue
- 2 pairs of kid-sized scissors
- 3 reams of copy paper
- 1 pencil box
- 1 package baby wipes
- 5 packages of 24 count crayons
- 1 package of colored pencils
- 1 (1.5 inch) binder (name printed on the binder is not necessary)
- 1 pallet of watercolors with a brush included
- 2 bottles of clear or white school glue
